

Paintings Sculpture and Graphics on Show

MADRAS, March 17.

Some lovely oils (figurative and landscape) fine graphics, exquisite sculpture (wood, plaster and terracottah) and items of collage, batik and ceramic ware, are on display at the Centenary Hall, Government Museum, Egmore. They constitute (about 80) an excellent cargo, comprising every branch of art.

Many of the exhibits maintain a high level, revealing the steady progress and achievement of the artists. Some among the award winners, merit high consideration. Among the oils, "Composition" by Rangaswami Sarangan, "Erosion" by A. P. Panneerselvam, "Composition C" by C. Murugesan, "Image" by C. Dakshinamoorthy are noteworthy for their draftsmanship, bold brush work and sense of colour. Sarangan's piece is striking for its embossed image and clarity of detail.
